## **Information by the responsible licensing and supervisory authority for employees in nuclear facilities**

Nuclear facilities represent objects in particular need of protection from possible unauthorized acts. This requires effective precautionary measures of a material, organizational and personnel kind.

One of these measures is verification of reliability pursuant to Section 12 b, Atomic Energy Act, of persons who have or who are to be provided access to the secure areas of nuclear facilities. In the Free State of Bavaria, this reliability check is carried out by the Bavarian State Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection (StMUGV) as the responsible authority under atomic energy law on the basis of information provided by the Bavarian police authority, the Bavarian authority for the protection of the constitution, the Chief Federal Prosecutor (Federal Records Office), and in cases concerning persons born before January 12, 1972 and resident in East Germany before January 12, 1990, by the Federal Representative for the Documents of the Former State Security Services of East Germany. The purpose of this reliability check is to protect against the occurrence of unauthorized acts that could lead to the theft or major release of radioactive material. The reliability check thus serves the protection of the general public and your own person.

The reliability check takes place in such a way that the Bavarian Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection enquires of the above authorities whether they are in possession of facts which, with regard to protection against disruptive measures by third parties, could give rise to reservations concerning the reliability of an employee or his/her access or deployment in the secure areas of nuclear facilities. Requests for investigation above and beyond this may not be made of these authorities. If the information provided by these authorities gives rise to findings that indicate the unreliability of a candidate or employee, the Bavarian Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection can obtain further information in clarification from other public bodies.

If, due to the findings of the reliability check, the Bavarian Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection has doubts concerning a person's reliability, the person shall be given an opportunity to put forward his/her case.

The data obtained in individual cases from the consulted bodies may only be used by the Bavarian Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection for the purpose of verifying reliability and may not be disclosed by these authorities to other public bodies.

All data shall be treated in accordance with Section 12 b, Atomic Energy Act as well as the relevant federal and Bavarian data protection provisions.

The reliability check can only be carried out if you provide your written consent on the declaration form. Should you decline to provide your consent - which you are entitled to do - it will not be possible to check your reliability. In this case, your access to the respective nuclear facility or assumption of a respective task cannot be permitted.

The declaration form is to be submitted - in a closed envelope if you so require - to the holder of the license to operate the Bavarian nuclear facility, which will forward it to the Bavarian Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection.

You will generally avoid a repeated screening of your person in the near future if you declare that the Facility Security Officer initiating the reliability check can pass on the result, if positive (i.e. no objections), to the license holder of other nuclear facilities in which your employment is also intended.

Pursuant to the Bavarian Data Protection Act (BayDSG), the Bavarian Data Protection Commissioner monitors the compliance of public bodies with the provisions of the Bavarian Data Protection Act and other data protection provisions.

In accordance with Clause 30, paragraph 2, sentence 2 of the Bavarian Data Protection Act (BayDSG), person related data kept in files created in connection with verification of your reliability under atomic energy law will not be included in the monitoring conducted by the Bavarian Data Protection Commissioner if you object to such inspection of your data. Your objection must be submitted in writing to the Bavarian State Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection. You can either declare your objection in the Declaration Form for Verification of Reliability under Atomic Energy Law, or send your objection directly to the Bavarian State Ministry of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection.
